William M. Gardner, Jr., OL, R.I.P.

Dear Friends in the Royal Martyr -

I write to share with you that I received notice from Fr. Jim Monroe, SSC, a member and Secretary of our Board of Trustees, of the entrance into the Church Expectant of one of our most devoted workers on the Board of Trustees, Bill Gardner, who died of an apparent heart attack on Tuesday the 22nd of May at his home in Florida. Fr. Monroe has been in a pastoral role with Bill in two different churches. At the time of his death, Bill was a member of Guardian Angels parish in Lantana, Florida, where a requiem was held on Saturday, June 2^{nd} . He will be interred in Druid Ridge Cemetery, located at 7900 Park Heights Avenue in Pikesville, just to the NW of Baltimore on Friday, June 8th, at 11:00 a.m. The officiant will be Fr. Fred Thomas, SSC, of Grace & St. Peter's Church. Doug Ruff, who succeeded Bill as Treasurer and is our current Vice President and David Lewis, our present Treasurer and Membership Secretary note that Bill had "one of the strongest set of SKCM leadership credentials around, including Council of the American Branch (2007-2008), Membership Secretary, American Region (1995-2009), Trustee (2008-2012), [and] Treasurer (2008-2009)." He also had long-standing connections with Dr. Mark Wuonola, who preceded me as President and is the present editor of SKCM News, not only as alumni of M.I.T. but also as parishioners at both S. Clement's in Philadelphia (where he offered in 1995 to be Membership Secretary on his own initiative) and the Church of the Advent in Boston. The two of them worked closely together in administering the Society during the pre-incorporation years. Bill is survived by a sister, who continues to live in the Baltimore area. Please remember Bill in your prayers.

While I am writing, I am happy to report that the *Devotional Manual* is now with the printer and should be done soon. The tentative ship date from the printer is this coming Friday, June 8th.
