The artist with whom we most closely associate with Charles I is Sir Anthony van Dyke. Born on the 23rd of March, 1599 in Antwerp, his talent for painting was recognized at an early age. His *Self-Portrait* painted when he was only fifteen demonstrates his abilities at such young age. He became chief assistant to Peter Paul Rubens whose influence on van Dyck was immense.

In 1620, George Villiers, the Duke of Buckingham and James I advisor, brought van Dyck to England as a court painter. He periodically returned to Flanders but with Antwerp's influence waning, traveled throughout Europe, notably Italy, studying the great Venetian masters, particularly Titian and generating quite a reputation as a portrait artist, especially among the Genoese aristocracy.

With the accession of Charles, who was a passionate collector of art, van Dyck assisted Charles's agents in the procurement of European works as well as supplying them with some of his own paintings. In April of 1632, van Dyck returned to England, this time to work in the court of Charles I. Here his paintings were intended to buttress the King's conviction of "the divine right of kings." Van Dyck painted 37 pictures of Charles and 35 of Queen Henrietta Maria. The best of them include; *Equestrian Portrait of Charles I, King of England with Seignior de St. Antoine* (1633), *Queen Henrietta Maria with Sir Jeffrey Hudson* (1633), *Charles I, King of England, at the Hunt* (1635) *Charles I, King of England* (1636), *Charles I, King of England, from Three Angles* (1636), *Children of Charles I* (1635), *Equestrian Portrait of Charles I, King of England* (1638), many of which are available through the SKCM website for purchase.



But van Dyck also painted religious themes, among the most famous, and which hangs at the National Gallery of Art, is *The Assumption of the Virgin* (1628/1629).

Also called *The Virgin as Intercessor*, van Dyck depicts the Blessed Mother gazing heavenward with open hands, signifying her role as intercessor given to the faithful by Our Lord at the foot of the cross.

As we approach this great summer feast, The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, may we appreciate Sir Anthony van Dyck's contribution in this tender exposition of the catholic faith.

Society News

We're currently at **418 members in the SKCM American Region!** Some 48 of us are new or reinstated members; with six weeks remaining in the fiscal year, it is likely that we will exceed last year's higher-than-usual total of 49 new members. During the current fiscal year to date we have lost 6 members to death, one to resignation, and 20 to nonpayment of dues, so we have gained nearly two members for every one lost. A half dozen of our members are student members, who pay \$10/year rather than the standard \$15. And we are at a record 65 Life Members, a net increase of six from a year ago and a clear testimony to the allegiance of these members to the Society and its devotional purpose.

We're developing additional devotional materials for membership use. Two of them are propers for two Caroline anniversaries in addition to Royal Martyr Day (see below). Others include holy cards for the Royal Martyr and for his beatification. Still more: *Is Charles I a Saint*, prepared by our member Charles Coulombe and among other things helpful to rebut allegations that KCM was anti-Catholic, and an additional devotional manual to complement the several already available. Prompted by our running out of several Caroline postcards, we've also begun investigation of how and from where to move on this front.

Society members are invited to submit nominations for Board of Trustees consideration as members of the Order of Blessed William Laud, Abp. & Martyr. Today the rolls of this select group include over 50 members and supporters of the Society, in this life and the next, designated since the creation of this recognition in 2009.

In accordance with Board policy, the members of the Order are elected "in recognition of contributions rising to a certain level, or higher, of significance as to impact and benefit to the Society by members and supporters who are not members ... Election to membership in the Order of Laud shall be considered equivalent to the designation of Benefactor status with regard to impact and benefit to the Society." Just as Benefactors are entitled to use "Ben." after their names, Order of Laud members may use "OL".

Such nominations, giving background on the candidate and stating why he or she should be honored, should be sent by **2 November 2018** to The Ven. James G. Regular Devotions Suggested for American Region Members

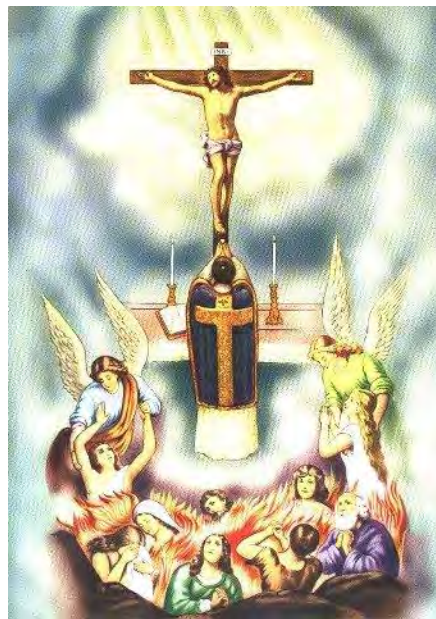
The *Devotional Manual* for the use of Society members reminds us of our obligation to organize and participate in a Royal Martyr Day service on or around 30 January. We are also called upon to organize and encourage the observation of other Caroline anniversaries during the year, three of them being the Recognition of the *Cultus* (Canonization; 26 April), Restoration Day (29 May), and the Nativity (19 November). In the near future, as noted above the Society will be publishing liturgical propers for Restoration Day and the Nativity, in addition those heretofore made available for Royal Martyr Day; thus we will be following the pattern of our Mother Society in the United Kingdom. It is not by accident that most editions of the *Communique*, including the current one, begin with a reflection on a seasonal Caroline or related anniversary. Remember!

The Manual also advocates that one set a daily or weekly time for personal SKCM devotions, which should complement or supplement one's usual devotions. SKCM devotions are suggested to include the day's or week's collect, reflection on an event from the Manual's *Kalendar of Anniversaries*, and other features, in

particular praying for the souls of the former members who have passed from this life to the next on the particular day or week. (If you do not have the *Manual*, it is one of the Society goods available for purchase, and it is given to each new member without charge.)

As a devotional society it is important for us to remember the years' minds for the day or week. The *Devotional Manual* contains a *Necrological Calendar* incorporating the names in question and continues with appropriate prayers for the dead and dying. The Calendar contained in the Manual was updated on 2 December 2017. Since the *Necrological Calendar* is updated on a continuing basis, including adding the dates of death of former members when available, we are attaching an updated version with this edition of the *Communique*. You are encouraged to include its contents as an ongoing part of your prayers.

Into Paradise may the Angels lead thee, at thy coming may the Martyrs receive thee, and bring thee into the holy city Jerusalem. May the quire of Angels welcome thee, and with Lazarus, who once was poor, mayest thou have eternal rest. Amen.

NOTES ON THE NECROLOGICAL CALENDAR

The plea that we remember the souls of our Society's departed members in our prayers and intentions is no more or less than a call to our Christian duty, to enable discharge of which this *Necrological Calendar* was prepared as a part of our *Devotional Manual*. New information and of course, new deaths, continually come to our attention. Therefore, we are providing this updated edition of the *Calendar* for your prayerful use.

In the first portion are listed the names of those, the dates (Day and Month) of repose of whose souls are not known. It is suggested that the list of those Departed Members with 'Dates Unknown' be divided into two parts (as shown, divided by a line space) for intercessory prayer. Those two groups of souls may be prayed for during June and July, two months in which our *Necrological Calendar* lists fewer names.

In the near future, we plan to include this Necrology, regularly updated, as a file for complementary download from the Society's website.
